**RE: THE PREMIER GUARANTEE  
APPROVAL OF EUROMAC2**

I refer to the above and my message left on your voicemail dated 16<sup>th</sup> October 2002.

I wish to now confirm that Euromac2 building systems have now been officially accepted for use in a Premier Guarantee home. Therefore, if a builder is building residential units and would like to use your Product, we can apply the Premier Guarantee 10-Year Structural Defects Insurance Policy to the units. There are three provisos however, which would need to be satisfied on a project by project basis before a particular unit can be approved. They are as follows: -

- 1) Foundations, DPC and DPM details are to be agreed on a project by project basis – Surveyor will be looking for a traditional detail.
- 2) Structural Calculations to be provided by a competent engineer on a project by project basis.
- 3) The full technical audit process will apply to each project.

If you are willing to agree to the above then Surveyor can progress the issues. The surveyor would basically be carrying out inspections as he would in every case. He also is trying to make sure that your system gets installed correctly, if the builders themselves are installing them.

I trust this is in order and await your advice.
